Arts

- ◆ Widened access to arts programmes for **>437,900** people (since FY10/11) (*>200,000 people in FY25/26*)
- ◆ Supported **518** artists through **28** community, lunchtime and digital performances in FY25/26
- ◆ **24** visual arts engagement activities in FY25/26 featuring our three Mapletree Public Art Trails

Education



Youths aged 7 to 16 refined their futsal skills
and bonded with friends at the Mapletree
Youth Futsal Camp 2025.

- ◆ Enhanced education opportunities with **>7,900** scholarships and bursaries awarded (since FY10/11) (*366 awards in FY25/26*)
- ◆ Alleviated financial difficulties for **91** students with **>S\$281,500** disbursed through our Mapletree Youth Resilience Programme in FY25/26
- ◆ Engaged **135** students through our Mapletree Youth Futsal Camp 2025
- ◆ Rallied **105** staff, tenants and beneficiaries to participate in our Mapletree Futsal Challenge 2025, raising **S\$24,000** for charity

Environment



Mapletree staff participated in a

- ◆ Engaged **>118,300** people through environmental conservation initiatives in **13** markets (since FY10/11) (*54,600 people in FY25/26*)
- ◆ Harvested **>58kg** of leafy greens and herbs from the Mapletree Edible Garden in FY25/26
- ◆ Planted **>14,500** trees in the community across **13** markets in FY25/26

Healthcare



Mapletree Community Impact Programme
launched by Mapletree and the Singapore
International Foundation.

- ◆ Our support has touched **>180,100** lives (since FY10/11)
- ◆ A key highlight was the launch of the Mapletree Community Impact Programme in November 2025. Through a partnership with the Singapore International Foundation, Mapletree committed **S\$250,000** to support healthcare volunteerism initiatives in India and Vietnam.
- ◆ The initiative is expected to benefit **>47,000** patients and caregivers over **3** years.
